One of the new pieces, donated by the son of Endre Simonyi – a pioneer of personal computing in Hungary, founder and first president of the Hungarian Computer Constructors' Club (HCC) – was the metal case of one of his father's very first home-built computers, along with the SWTPC CT-64 terminal used with the machine.
