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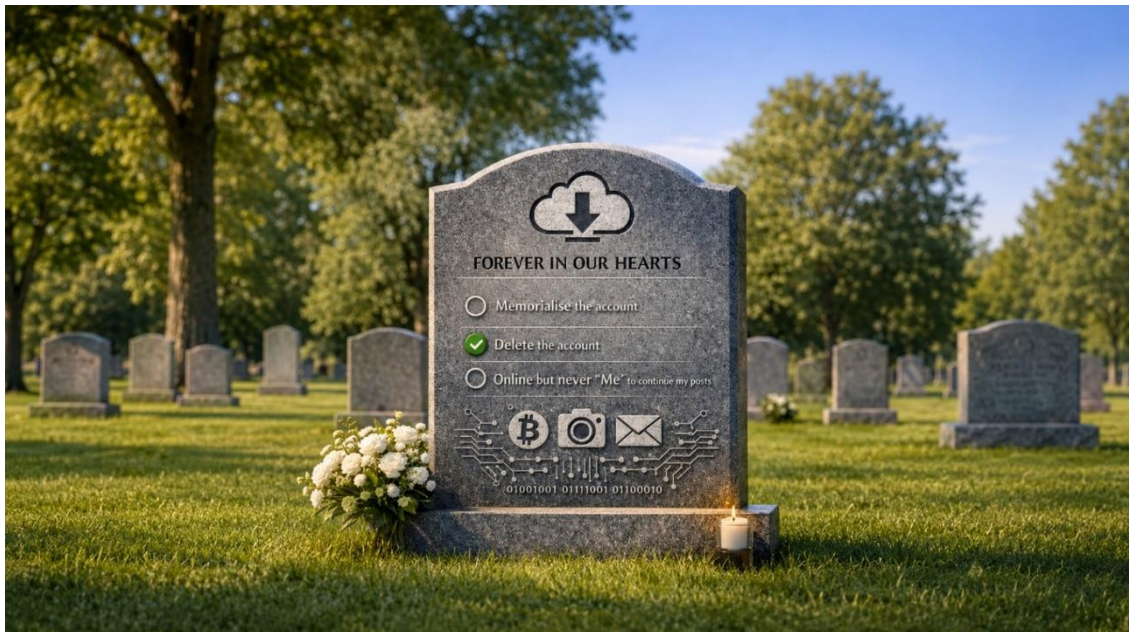
WG 8.3 and WG 12.15 Join Forces for AI-Focused Conference
