Cedefop Releases Publications on Adapting VET for Green and Digital Future

The European Centre for the development of Vocational Training (Cedefop) has recently released several publications as part of its "Al futures of work" project. The second publication, "<u>VET needs to go digital</u>", draws on Cedefop's second European Skills and Jobs Survey (ESJS2) to advocate for a renewed digital skills push in VET.
